At 0243 hours had a call from Sgt Keith Frampton, RCMP. Grand Falls Windsor RCMP, along with GSAR are presently searching for a missing 74 year old male. The man, from St John's, has a cabin in the area. The man's pick up truck was located but no signs of the individual. The individual has a medical history of diabetes.

Gov Air Services contacted at 0258 to arrange air support for first light. Due to weather and visibility, GAS saying they may not be able to fly.
