



a. What: Humanitarian search in support of NL Provincial GSAR. Missing person search

b. Where: South side of Red Indian Lake, which is located 40 NM south east of Deer Lake, NL

c. When: JRCC received the initial call from NL Gov't Air Svcs at 0541Z

d. Who: Ongoing search for a 74 YOM, diabetic. 103 Sqn Cormorant (R912) has been tasked.

e. Why: 74 YOM was reported missing earlier in the evening. Local GSAR team is on scene and has been searching for a while already. GSAR made a request to NL Gov't Air Svcs for Air support, but they were unable to support due to the weather and the fact that their helos can only fly during the daytime.

f. Action Taken: R912 will proceed to the search area and carry out an expanding square search of the area.
