SWEETAPPLE - Missing Person 2013-07-30

0800 Meeting at GFW detachment with
Cpl. Paul, S/Sgt. BRUSHET, Cpl. Fawer, Lt.
Jock and myself.

- File discussed / update on search from
Cpl. Paul, efforts have ceased at this
point.

To do:

- Visit truck and search / obtain photos
- Visit Cabin and search / obtain photos
- Speak w/ gas station - clerk Millertown
- Speak w/ searchers who searched
truck and cabin
- There was mention of money taken out
for work at the cabin, try and locate
wallet / money

Deputed GFW enroute to Millertown
Cpl. PAUL ahead of writer also
attending with Rod DYKE to open

1241

Arrived at the Truck owned by
SWEETAPPLE.

While at the truck DYKE opened the truck for patios.

The truck was searched, there was no wallet or money found in the vehicle other than change and a 5\$ bill. To note there was clothing in the vehicle, there was a pair of glasses in the vehicle and 2 water bottles.

1310 2 Water Bottles seized from centre console of truck

The area around the vehicle was searched. It was noted that the bog was only approx 50-70 ~~meters~~ feet through a wooded area from the truck. There was a trail from the side of the truck to the bog that was quite evident.

The area around the truck and wooded area beyond the truck had water bottles scattered throughout

It was unknown at the time whether or not the articles around the area were from searchers or the lost person.

1315 left the area of the truck and proceeded to main Rd. While travelling to main Rd. a note was spoken to who had been helping on the search days previous. He was headed up to continue searching alone. Ralph Meadus

Grades Cove, Trinity Bay.

Travelled 31 km's from truck on main Rd. and that is where the road started to SWEETAPPLE'S cabin.

1428 Attended the cabin of SWEETAPPLE it was 4.9 km's from main road. Cpl. PAUL had a key and opened the cabin up.

Wifes searched the cabin while
Cst. Jack obtained photo's.

The cabin was very neat and clean.
There was nothing disturbed
or a ~~search~~ ~~stained~~. The fridge
had food inside and there were
groceries on the counter top.

A search of bedrooms was compl.
There was a pair of shorts and
jeans found on the bed. The
jeans showed evidence that
a wallet was ~~found~~ in the
back pocket (photo obtained)

There was a receipt found in
the shorts pocket that was
from Scotia Bank for \$1000.00
withdrown on July 26th 2013,
a fine was not given on receipt.

Medication was found on the
kitchen table along with a
print out of RX's from the
pharmacy. Some was obtained
and seized from table @ 1530

Search of the shed on the

showed no signs of being disturbed. Items such as generator / snowmobile / chainsaw ect. were located inside.

Nothing around the property seemed out of place or disturbed

1530 Left the cabin and proceeded to main road after seizing the Rx's meds list

1600 Arrived at Millertown gas station / convenience store and spoke to clerk who advised that Sis Blunden had spoke to SWEETAPPLE on Friday past.

1625 Attended the residence of Sis Blunden in Millertown. Ct. JACK obtained a statement from Blunden.

1645. Departed Millertown

1830 Attended GFW detachment and was 10-35.

0900 Meeting GFW Det.

Discussed investigation from
day before.

To Do: ① Speak to Bank about money
withdrawal and poss. video.

② Speak to Mrs. SWEETAPPLE about
how much money and when it was
taken out.


③ Contact SAR leaders for meeting
following day to discuss search
efforts.

1050 Attended ScotiaBank and spoke
with personell. The receipt was
shown to staff who advised that
the money would have been taken
out on Friday 26th by a teller.
An inquiry to their account showed
that it was at 11:26 AM on Friday
the 26th of July. The staff advised
that they would get video for writer
and contact when ready.

2018/08/01

1100 Contact made to Scotia Bank
left details to return call about
video SURV.


1200 Cont. JACK advised that Lt.
Lee CUSH had contacted him and
new information had come to
him about a person of interest.



2010 Called and spoke to Ralph Meadors and he advised that there would be no where else to search close to the fork, advised that SWEETAPPLE was somewhere around that bog. He advised that Allan Hancock would know best.

2026 Call made to Allan Hancock, he advised that there was no where else to search and that SWEETAPPLE had to be somewhere close to the bog. He believes that SWEETAPPLE got turned around and walked off the bog in the wrong direction.

This information was passed on to Cpl. FEWER who would be assisting the search teams in the morning.



SWEETAPPLE - Missing Person

2013-08-02

11:00 I was advised that SWEETAPPLE had been found alive

11:18 Spoke with Cpl FEWER who advised he was in Chopper with SWEETAPPLE and enroute to Buckens med. Clinic. At this time Cst. Hogen had advised that he was on the line with Buckens Med. and they advised that victim to go to GFW hospital. FEWER advised there was not enough fuel to get to GFW and they would head to Pasadena.

11:21 Spoke with FEWER advised that he should go to CB. as the Med. Clinic in Pasadena was very small.

11:23 Cst. Jack advised that the chopper was not clear to land in CB.

11:28 Cst. Jack contacted FEWER and advised to land in Pasadena and Ambulance would meet there.

1145 Cpl. FEWER advised chopper landed
and was met by Ambulance.
