Searches

- So far in 2021 we have responded to 34 searches
- Busiest during spring, summer and fall
- Average 721 volunteer hours in searching each month
- Note that 2020 seen to be opposite with majority of searches late fall winter and early spring. 29 searches in total and 18,528 hours on searches
- Majority of searches seem to be Hikers and mental illness (despondent, autistic, dementia)

Fundraising

- In 2019 member provided 1,744 hours in fundraising and community events
- In 2020 member provided 11.5 hours in fundraising and community events
- Covid had and continues to have a significant impact on our fundraising efforts
- Operational cost of building and equipment run our team around \$15,000 per year.
- We have light bills during the winter which are over \$2,000 a month.

- Yearly vehicle inspections and maintenance cost between \$5,000 to \$10,000
